- Our records indicate that the Richard C. Hunter High School located at LPRC
- Road in Gardnersville, Monrovia has a contract with UNDP under the Formal
- Education component of the DDRR program. Presently there are 78
- beneficiaries (Demobilized Ex-combatants) of the DDRR program enrolled in
- the school and are receiving formal education in a normal education setting
- as their reintegration benefit. Their benefit includes the following:
 - 1. Tuition
 - 2. Payment for books
 - 3. Uniform
 - 4. Footwear
 - 5. Exam fees
 - 6. US\$30.00 monthly stipend during the first academic year (9 months).
 - US\$15.00 monthly stipend during the second academic year (9 months)
 - US\$.0.00 during the third and final academic year of the support.
- The support continues as long as the beneficiary meets the following
- requirements:
 - 1. 75% attendance record
 - 2. Pass exams
 - 3. Good conduct.
